Definition: *Strong's*:

1. Teaching
 - a. That which is taught
 - b. Doctrine, teaching, concerning something

2. The act of teaching, instruction
 - a. In religious assemblies of the Christians, to speak in the way of teaching, in distinction from other modes of speaking in public
